## State Conference Information:

- All applications are due in the State Office by February 26, 2010. This includes State Officers Applications, Service Award, National HOSA week, etc.
- Registration is on line through National HOSA, following the instruction sheet on website. Each chapter needs to register two voting delegates and one nominating committee member.
- If an advisor chairs two events, the conference registration fee is waived.
- Any chaperones or guests signed up under their local chapter membership as an alumni member, their registration is only \$20, and all other participants are \$75.00.
- All chapters must stay at the Circus Circus in Reno to be eligible for competition. The room block is under Nevada HOSA and the room cost is \$62.00 plus tax.
- The official HOSA uniform is required this year at SLC.
- Registration checks should be made out to Nevada HOSA.
- At registration on Sunday, only the **advisor** will be allowed to register their chapter and must have all the medical releases and Code of Conduct forms for their students. It is the advisor responsibility to make sure that the participants are HOSA members in good standing.
- There are two new Competitive Events this year: **Emergency Medical Technician and Public Health Emergency Preparedness.**
- Please read competitive event guidelines and know what supplies the competitor must bring to the event.
- State Officer Application and Handbook is on the website.
- Please discuss the Nevada HOSA by laws with your chapter and the changes recommended, give a copy to your voting delegates.
- The conference schedule is similar to last year. The tests will be in the Ballrooms with tables this year. Bring clipboards for the competitive events and lots of pencils. These will not be provided for the tests.
- The conference sessions will be held at the University of Nevada Reno, Joe Crowley Student Union. The competitive events will be held at UNR, TMCC and the Regional Training Facility.
